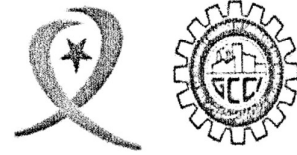

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING/COOPERATION AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN  
PAKISTAN AMERICAN BUSINESS ASSOCIATION  
AND  
GUJRANWALA CHAMBER OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY**

**INTRODUCTION**

With the desire to hold an International Convention and a Trade Show in Washington, D.C., the Pakistan American Business Association, a (501) (C) non-profit organization located in Virginia, USA, hereinafter referred to as "PABA", and the Gujranwala Chambers of Commerce and Industry, hereinafter referred to as "The Chamber", have agreed to the following to accomplish mutually beneficial objectives.

**Purpose:** The purpose of this agreement is to cooperate in holding an International Convention and Trade Show in Washington D.C. under the aegis of PABA.

**Article One :** PABA and the Chamber have agreed to work together to hold an International Convention and Trade Show in Washington D.C. within three years.

**Article Two:** A committee will be formed, comprising Chairman PABA and the sitting president of the Chamber to formulate a practical framework for holding the Convention.

**Article Three:** The Committee will have a quarterly meeting to discuss the progress and the future course of action with an aim to ensure the holding of convention within the given time-frame. The committee will decide about the modus-operandi of holding the meeting.

**Article Four:** A Secretariat will be set up by the Chamber and persons will be dedicated to carry out day-to-day work/communication between the PABA and the Chamber to implement the framework of holding the convention and the trade show.

**Article Five:** The Chamber will facilitate PABA in contacting companies in Pakistan and registering them for the convention. The Committee through mutual consent will form a criteria for selecting companies for the Convention. The Committee will also decide about the fee for companies to sign up for the Convention.

**Article Six:** PABA will contact U.S. companies and Pakistani American businessmen who are interested in taking part in the Convention. The Chamber can also help identify companies in USA which can be invited and registered for the event.

**Article Seven:** The Chamber will help PABA to work as a bridge between Pakistani companies and their American counterparts to make this Convention a success.

**Article Eight:** PABA and the Chamber will encourage the exchange of trade delegations, before and after the Convention, to achieve the set objectives.


**Article Nine:** The Chamber and PABA will share, on a monthly basis, the progress made with regard to registration and other relevant information. The registration will be done online through PABA's official web-site and would be duly communicated to the Chamber.


**Article Ten:** PABA and the Chamber will launch campaign in their respective countries to generate interest for the Convention.

**Article Eleven:** For the purpose of implementing this MoU/Agreement, PABA and the Chamber will jointly review the provisions, taking into consideration the new matters and issues that may come up from time-to-time, necessitating the need for introducing new articles, or amending the existing ones. The MoU/Agreement may be amended at any time subject to agreement between PABA and the Chamber.

**Article Twelve:** The MoU/Agreement shall come into effect upon signature by Chairman PABA and sitting president of the Chamber, and shall remain in effect until both, or any of the two, request its termination. The MoU/Agreement may be terminated at any time after consultations within the Committee.
